


With Destiny 23.0, enjoy a refreshed design with more efficient navigation, enhanced reporting tools, and more.


Explore the new look

Previous versions of Destiny featured navigation across the top and sides. Destiny 23.0 introduces a modern design with centralized side navigation. The features you use every day, like checking out books, haven't changed. You'll find them organized in the same way, through the new sidebar. Just follow your usual process to do your work.






Switch between sites, pages, and products with ease

The primary navigation bar, available at the top of every page, lets you quickly jump between areas in Destiny and across Follett products.

Note: The options you see depend on your access level, region, and product access.



Move between products and pages

Use the Applications menu to navigate between Follett Software products and pages. The options you see will vary based on your access level, region, and product access. The full list of options includes:



Customize your experience

Destiny 23.0 introduces the ability to set individual, site, and district preferences.

Click the Profile icon (2) to access:

- Profile: Edit profile settings, including your profile image.
- Preferences: Set default site/district and the product you see on login.

Note: This feature is not available to the following roles (defined in Access Levels): Student, Guest, Learner, Member, and Observer.

• **District and Site Settings:** Set logos and add custom content – including text, images, and links – to your district home page (with the appropriate permissions).



Access familiar features and workflows faster

Find all the Destiny features and workflows you're familiar with in a more intuitive layout. The screenshot shows where to perform each of the following steps.

- 1. Use the collapsible sidebar to access a menu with the following: Catalog, Circulation, Reports, and Admin.
- 2. Click an option.
- 3. Some pages have tabs. Click the appropriate tab for the task you want to perform.




Use the secondary navigation bar

The secondary navigation bar gives you access to:

- Breadcrumbs: See where you are in the product.
- Reset Page: Clear previous selections (on Circulation pages).
- Language: Select a language (on Catalog pages, if enabled at your school. Not shown above).
- **Product switcher:** If you have multiple Destiny Back Office products, switch between them, or view all at once.

Unlock your experience

The login page has an updated look. You can still log in to Destiny using single sign-on (SSO) with Google or another protocol, or your Destiny username and password. **Log in as guest** routes users to Library Search.






Increase student visibility to your resources

Previous version of Destiny Discover





Get quick data insights and recommendations with Site and District Dashboards

Site and District Dashboards provide a graphical, at-a-glance view of various library and resource data.



The Site Library Dashboard also features purchasing recommendations for your school.



Notes about Dashboards:

- The Recommendations widget is currently only available to US-based Destiny customers who are Destiny Cloud-hosted.
- Access to the Site and District Dashboards requires the appropriate access level permissions.
- In Resource Manager, you can only access the resources you have permission to view.



Meet Destiny AI: Data Assistant

Destiny AI: Data Assistant provides instant answers to questions about your resources. This powerful tool offers reporting and insights, all in a simple conversational interface. Destiny v23.0 extends its capabilities to include both Library Manager and Resource Manager.




Ask anything. Type your question or request, or pick a prompt suggestion.

Get immediate results. The data you need appears instantly, sometimes in the form of a table. Sort, filter, re-size columns, and download directly from the chat.

Refine. Want more specific data? Keep the conversation going, and Destiny AI: Data Assistant will adjust the report in real time.

Destiny AI: Data Assistant must be enabled by a Destiny Administrator. Once enabled, access it from your Site Dashboard.



Notes about Destiny AI: Data Assistant:

- Currently only available to US-based Destiny customers who are Destiny Cloud-hosted.
- Must be enabled by a Destiny Administrator. Once enabled, it can take several hours to be accessible.
- Access requires the appropriate access level permissions.
- There are two plan options:
 - Free plan: Limited to 100 queries per district
 - Premium plan: Unlimited queries, recommendations, and more

Additional Notes about Destiny v23.0:

Update bookmarks

If you previously bookmarked specific Destiny pages using your browser, you might need to update them. If you encounter a screen that looks unfamiliar or different from the new look and feel of v23.0, do the following:


- 1. In your browser, enter and navigate to the main Destiny URL for your district.
 - If you are a Follett Destiny® Cloud-hosted customer, this format is typically your district name. follett destiny.com.
 - If your district is self-hosted, the format varies.
- 2. From this page, log in to Destiny (From the top-right, click 2).

You should now have access to the most up-to-date Destiny experience. From here, you can use your browser to create new bookmarks as you navigate Destiny.

Get shareable links

To get shareable links to Destiny Back Office and Destiny Discover for specific sites:

- 1. Go to your district homepage: From the site selector, select **District View**.
- 2. Next to the site you want to get links for, click .
- 3. Click Copy Destiny Back Office Link or Copy Destiny Discover Link.



4. Paste the copied link where you want it to appear.
